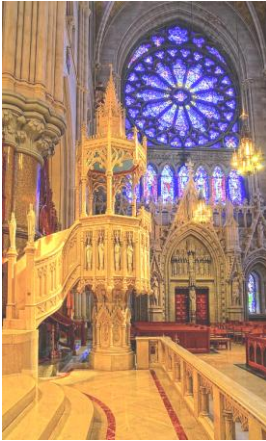

The Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Newark, NJ

The cornerstone was laid on June 11, 1899 and the cathedral was dedicated on October 19, 1954. It was built using a French Gothic design, it has 45,000 square feet and towers that are 323 feet high and is the 5th largest cathedral in North America with the largest pipe organ ever built by the Schantz Organ Co. Pope John Paul II celebrated Holy Mass at the Cathedral in October of 1995, when he conferred the title of Minor Basilica to Sacred Heart Cathedral giving it its current name, Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart.
